

Further Information

- **Teachers**—we have qualified teachers on staff who can deliver academic subjects and can support students with work from school or our own resources.
- **Maths, English, ICT, Science**—we embed these core skills along with others into our teaching.
- **AQA** Unit award scheme allows students to gain awards for areas of interest to them. The AQA awards can be personalized to meet the specific needs and level (from pre entry to level 3) of the student, thus making them achievable targets.
- **ASDAN**—we support other organisations in the delivery of Bronze, Silver, Gold as well as the Certificate of Personal Effectiveness (CoPE). (CoPE attracts points for schools).
- **Kennel Club and IABTC** the KCAI scheme and other dog training awards can be accessed via HSC.
- All sessions are supported by easily accessible written work. Students are fully supported with one to one help where appropriate and specially developed work sheets to guide them through the learning process.
- All students build up a portfolio of evidence (written and photographic) of their work at the Haxey Study Centre. This is structured to provide the evidence required for various awards or qualifications.
- We are a small friendly centre and are extremely flexible. You are welcome to come along, have a look around and discuss the needs of your organization or individuals within it.
- Students of all ages can be supported at Haxey Study Centre. There is no upper or lower age limit.

We are accustomed to developing individual learning plans for children from various educational backgrounds including special schools and colleges, PRUs, looked after children, or main stream school. Many of our children are vulnerable, school excluded, or unable to cope with the usual school system. They come with varying abilities and educational standards and needs. Our tutors work with them to develop their confidence, social, vocational and academic skills.

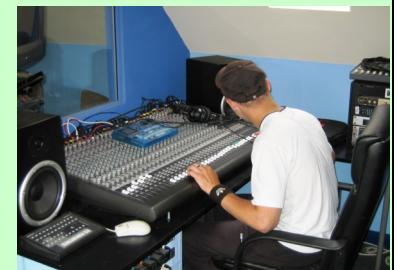

ANIMAL CARE

The Haxey Study Centre has a large range of animals available to aid the learning experience. Many of the animals are rescued and taken into the Centre's sanctuary. The students are shown the correct handling and care procedures to keep both animal and handler safe. They will also cover, feeding, accommodation, behaviour, grooming, health care, origin, environmental enrichment, legalities, moralities, training and welfare. AQA unit awards available.

We have a large range of animals that may vary from time to time including:

- **Birds**—Barn owl, tawny owl, Bengal eagle owl, chickens.
- **Reptiles**—bearded dragon, gecko, skink, snakes, chameleon.
- **Amphibians**—White's tree frog, fire bellied toads, common toads and frogs.
- **Small Animals**—chinchilla, degu, gerbils, mice, rats, guinea-pigs, rabbits, hamsters, ferrets, chipmunk.
- **Mini-beasts**—tarantula, giant millipede, scorpion, hissing cockroaches, giant African land snails, stick insects, praying mantis, rainbow crab
- **Larger Animals**—Horses, pigs, sheep, cats, dogs. (and occasionally puppies.)



CANINE CARE and TRAINING

There are approximately 10 dogs permanently on site—Leonbergers, Pyrenean Sheepdogs, Labrador and Border Collies these are used for breeding, training and also work with the students. Other dogs (including gundogs, terriers, cross breeds, and more) are brought in from time to time. Students will learn grooming, socialisation, obedience training, agility, various other dog sports, health care, welfare, disease prevention, behaviour management, law and responsibilities of dog ownership. Working towards various IABTC dog training certificates and may also work towards KCAI, AQA units and other awards.



HORTICULTURE

We have a large organic garden where the students raise plants from seed and enjoy the experience of growing real food. This helps them to understand where food comes from and introduces them to propagation, weed control, pest control, soil management, team work and much more. There are raised beds, poly tunnel, cold frames, compost heaps etc.



CONSERVATION, WOODLAND SKILLS & BUSHCRAFT

In conjunction with the Forestry Commission, we have planted over **7500 trees** on our own land. Students will take part in caring for the woodland ensuring that it is safe for visitors and a perfect haven for wildlife. Students will learn how to identify trees and care for them. They will learn: coppicing, pollarding, stock fencing, reserve maintenance, footpath safety, style and gate making, making wildlife ponds, plant and wildlife identification, woodland skills & crafts. We can also offer **Bushcraft** including shelter building, fire lighting, camp cooking and other outdoor and survival skills.



WORKSHOP and CONSTRUCTION SKILLS



Students can learn how to use tools safely and develop skills in woodwork (turning, cutting, construction, design etc.). Green wood working skills using traditional tools e.g. pole lathe will be included. Also very popular options are welding, and vehicle restoration, and general maintenance. We even offer furniture restoration. We always endeavour to have real projects for students to work on.

MUSIC PRODUCTION and TECHNOLOGY

Technology

The centre boasts an up to date fully functioning recording studio 'Rough Track Recordings'. It includes: computer music systems, keyboards, drums, guitars etc. Students will learn sound recording, creation and manipulation, microphone techniques, mixing levels and acoustic dimension, external effects, composition skills, performance etc.



Musical Instruments

Students can also learn how to play various types of guitar, keyboard, drums or even develop their vocal skills under the guidance of qualified, professional musicians & singers.
